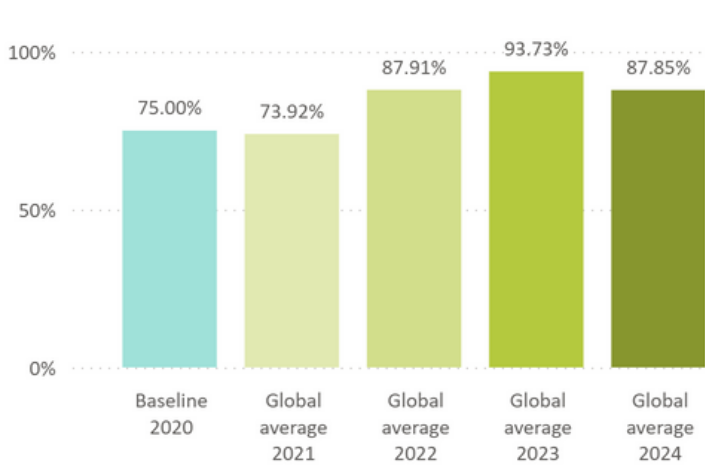

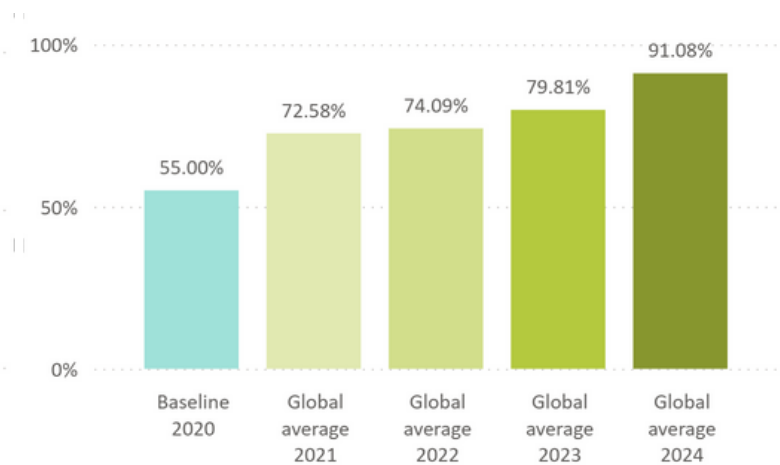
IMPACTFUL TRACK RECORDS

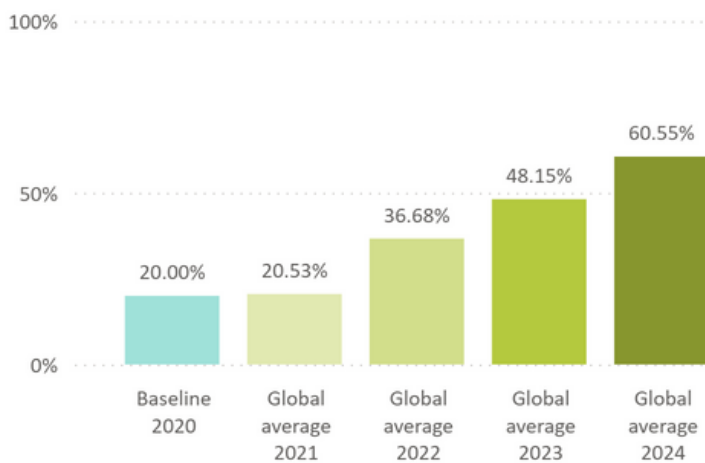
% OF PATIENTS SATISFIED WITH HEALTH SERVICE



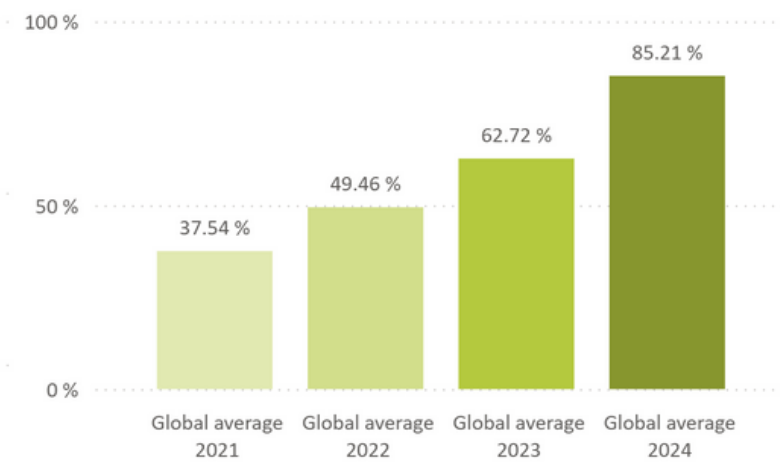
% OF PERSONS WITH DISABILITY REPORTING INCREASED SOCIAL ACCEPTANCE
